



# State Route 37 - Solano County Pavement Repair Project

## The Project

Caltrans will do extensive paving work on State Route 37 (SR 37) in Solano County for approximately two weeks to repair the roadway which has deteriorated over time.

## What to Expect

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, eastbound and westbound SR 37 must be completely closed between the Walnut Avenue Exit in Vallejo and SR 121 for two full weekends in September. During the work, SR 37 between SR 29 and Walnut Avenue will be available to local traffic only. Motorists may experience 15-45 minute delays depending on their destination.

## Detour Routes (when scheduled closures are in effect)

Westbound SR 37-Detour starts at SR 37/SR 29 Interchange. During SR 37 closures, westbound SR 37 motorists should use northbound SR 29, then southbound SR 121, and re-enter SR 37 at the SR 121/SR 37 Interchange.

Eastbound SR 37-Detour starts at SR 37/SR 121 Interchange. During SR 37 closures, eastbound SR 37 motorists should use northbound SR 121, then southbound SR 29, and then re-enter eastbound SR 37.

## Project Timeline

Repairs are scheduled during the two weekends of Friday, September 19 starting at 10 p.m. until Monday, September 22 at 5 a.m., and the following weekend, Friday, September 26 starting at 10 p.m. until Monday, September 29 at 5 a.m. Five weekday nights of work are scheduled from Monday, September 29 until Friday, October 3. Monday through Friday work will be scheduled from 10 p.m. each night until 5 a.m. the following morning. All work is weather permitting.

## Project Updates

Stationary mounted signs and changeable message signs (CMS) will be strategically placed to provide information regarding SR 37 closures and detours.
