



Highway 37-Solano Pavement Repair Project

The Project

Caltrans will do extensive paving work on Highway 37 in Solano County for approximately two weeks to repair the roadway which has deteriorated over time.

What to Expect

For the safety of workers and the traveling public, eastbound and westbound Highway 39 must be completely closed between Highway 29 and Highway 121 for two full weekends and five weekday nights during the repairs.

Detour Routes (when scheduled closures are in effect)

Westbound Highway 37-Detour starts at Highway 37/Highway 29 Interchange. During westbound Highway 37 closures, motorists should use northbound Highway 29, then southbound Highway 121, and re-enter Highway 37 at the Highway 121/Highway 37 Interchange.

Eastbound Highway 37-Detour starts at Highway 37/Highway 121 Interchange. During eastbound Highway 37 closures, motorists should use northbound Highway 121, then southbound Highway 29, then southbound Highway 29, then re-enter eastbound Highway 37.

Project Timeline

Repairs are scheduled during the two weekends of Friday, September 20 until Monday, September 23, and the following weekend, Friday, September 27 until Monday, September 30. Work on both weekends will start on Friday at 10 p.m. and be completed on Monday at 5 a.m. Five weekday nights of work are scheduled Monday, September 21 until Friday, September 27. Monday through Friday work is scheduled from 10 p.m. each night until 5 a.m. the following mornings. All work is weather permitting.

Project Updates

Stationary mounted signs and changeable message signs (CMS) will be strategically placed to provide information regarding Highway 37 closures and detours.
