


# STATE ROUTE-85 RAMP METERING PROJECT

## FROM STATE ROUTE 280 TO US 101



Beginning late fall, 2012, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will install 11 ramp metering elements and traffic operations systems in Santa Clara County on State Route 85 between I-280 in Cupertino and U.S.101 in Mountain View. The project will be completed in 2014.

The ramp metering work will be conducted in both the northbound and southbound directions in the cities of Cupertino, Los Altos, Sunnyvale and Mountain View from south of SR-85 / I-280 separation in Cupertino to SR-85 / U.S. 101 separation in Mountain View. In addition, the project will also widen five ramps along the corridor.

The implementation of ramp metering systems will enhance traffic flow on the freeway system, decrease travel time and improve mobility through the corridor during the peak hours.

### Construction Activities:

- Construction will be conducted mainly at night during the evening hours. Work will normally start as early as 7:00 p.m and end before 5:00 a.m. on weekdays.
- Ramp closures will occur Monday through Sunday during the evening hours, but can extend to later morning hours on the weekdays. Message signs and detour signs will be posted to assist motorists traveling through the area.
- Construction noise will be unavoidable; however, it will be kept within approved construction noise levels.
