NEW SPEED LIMIT FOR SECTION OF HIGHWAY 12 IN SOLANO COUNTY

Solano County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has introduced a new speed limit for the section of State Route 12 in Solano County that is currently undergoing rehabilitation.

The reduction from 55 mph to 45 mph took effect last week and only affects travel through the SR-12 construction zone, which stretches from east of Scandia Road in Suisun to Currie Road, which is just east of the Highway 113 junction.

Solar-powered red flashers within the 12-mile long project have been adjusted to reflect the new speed limit. "Slow For The Cone Zone" signs have also been installed along the project limits.

The speed-limit reduction is to enhance safety and will only be in effect for the duration of the project. Caltrans expects to complete the \$25.6 million project by December 2010.

Currently, all work on the project is being done behind k-rails (temporary concrete barriers) and it involves shoulder-widening.

Motorists are advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones and urged to "Slow For The Cone Zone."
