Highway 12 project in final phase; more closures planned

Solano County – Weather permitting, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled eight more nights of lane closures in the westbound direction of State Route 12 (Jameson Canyon) to enable completion of a 1.2 mile truck climbing lane project.

The night closures are all from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will extend from the I-80 connector with State Route 12 to a location half-mile west of Red Top Road.

Closures next week will be from Monday, November 3 at 9 p.m. through 6 a.m. on Tuesday, November 4. The same schedule will be repeated every night through 6 a.m. on Saturday, November 8.

There will be three more nights of closures the following week on Monday, November 10, Tuesday, November, 11 and Thursday, November 13.

During this period, the final placement of asphalt concrete, as well as concrete barrier installation will be done.

If weather disrupts the current schedule more night closures will have to be planned. Caltrans is on schedule to complete the truck climbing lane project by December 12.

Traffic heading for westbound SR-12 from Interstate-80 should detour by exiting on Highway 37 in Vallejo and then turning right onto Highway 29.

Eastbound lanes on SR-12 will remain open during this period, but motorists heading in that direction should expect some delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes if necessary.

Motorists are also advised that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones. Please “Slow For The Cone Zone.”
