

SBE & DVBE in A&E Contracts

- Small Business Council
 - Regular participant
 - Liaison between SBE Council and Division of Procurement and Contracts (DPAC)

- Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Goals
 - SBE overall District 4 Achievement to date: 49%
 - Contracts with goals of 25% or 50% SBE.
 - Goal equates to \$ 40 M for SBE.

- Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise (DVBE) Goals
 - DVBE achievement to date: 8%
 - Contracts with goals from 3%-45%.
 - Goal equates to \$ 9.0 M for DVBE



DBE in A&E Contracts

- DBE (Disadvantaged Business Enterprise)
 - Required when federal funds are used
 - % Statewide Goal is based on a Disparity Study.
 - Total Overall District Goal is: 23%
 - Goal Equates to \$ 24 M
 - District's Achieved to Date is: 26 %
 - Contract Goals varies from 13.5 % to 72 %
