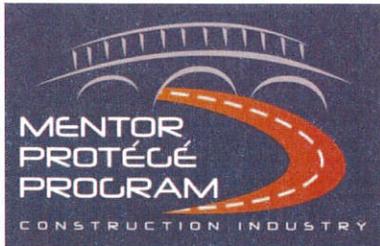

**The Caltrans District 4/AGC Mentor Protégé Program for Construction is in the second round of mentor-protégé relationships.**

**Potential protégés must meet the following criteria:** Small/emerging construction companies including DBE, DVBE and minority owned firms that have demonstrated some ability to succeed as a construction company, and are looking to grow and participate in public works projects.

- Construction companies only working within District 4 (9 Bay area counties)
- July 15, 2011: 8 protégé firms graduated from this program.
- ✓ 2011/2012: 2nd recruitment of Mentors and Protégés.
  - Added 3 Mentor firms (Webworm Builders, Skanska Construction, Ghilotti Construction Group). More mentors currently under consideration.
  - Over 300 protégé applications mailed out to protégé firms. 30 firms were shortlisted for pairing. 12 firms paired in April, 2012. We continue to establish new pairings.
  - Graduation expected in the spring of 2014.

**Moving Forward: Recruitment, pairing and growth of the program:**

- ✓ Refine the protégé application process and increase outreach efforts so as to attract firms more suited for public works construction work. Develop a website.
- ✓ Facilitate continuous recruitment of both mentors and protégés and continue making paired relationships. Goal: Increase mentor firms to 20 and paired relationships to 25.
- ✓ The goal is to implement this program statewide through each Caltrans District.

**Outreach efforts:** We continue to reach out to other agencies such as the Bay-area Small Business Outreach committee and other organizations to help recruit qualified mentors and protégés.

## ***PROGRAM OUTLINE***

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The California Department of Transportation, District 4 (Caltrans) and the Associated General Contractors of California, Inc. (AGC) entered into a partnership to jointly produce a mentor-protégé program for the construction industry in 2008. The key responsibility of the program is to structure the interaction between the mentors and their protégés, so that the latter can eventually build their own relationships. The goal of the program is to increase the number of companies that are able to successfully bid and complete public works projects in general and in particular the Caltrans transportation improvement projects. This program is consistent with the Governor's order No. S-11-06 to increase the participation of Small Business Enterprise (SBE) firms and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in the procurement and contracting of public works projects.

### **MENTOR-PROTÉGÉ PROGRAM IN DISTRICT 4**

Caltrans District 4 and AGC cooperated to implement a pilot mentor-protégé program. The key components of the program include:

Mentor firms: Established and successful construction companies that have a proven track record of successfully bidding and performing public works projects and have a willingness to help others succeed by sharing their knowledge and expertise.

Protégé firms: Small Business Enterprise firms, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises and emerging construction companies that have demonstrated some ability to succeed as a construction company, and are looking to grow and participate in public works projects.

Caltrans: Caltrans District 4 is pioneering in establishing this mentor-protégé program with the goal of spreading it statewide. Caltrans provides staff support, logistics, planning assistance and will recruit potential mentor and protégé firms to participate in the program. In addition, Caltrans will assist in coordinating training for the mentors and protégés.

AGC: AGC provides logistic support and helps recruit mentor firms to participate in the program. AGC also provides subsidized association membership to any protégé firms approved to enter the program, and deeply discounted membership for any new "emerging" firm that applies to be a protégé. AGC will provide access to AGC training classes and training materials for approved mentors and protégés on an as-needed basis.

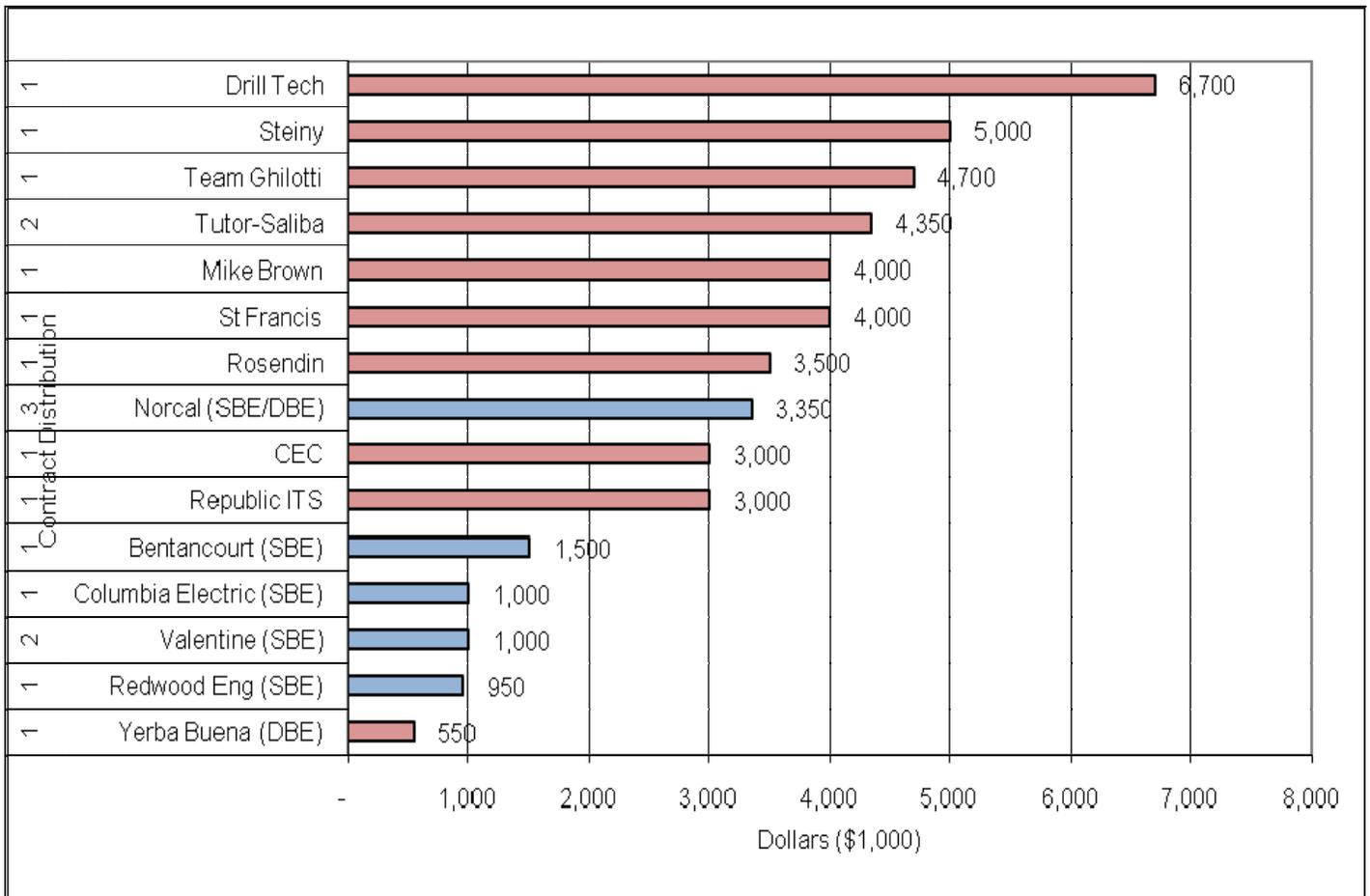
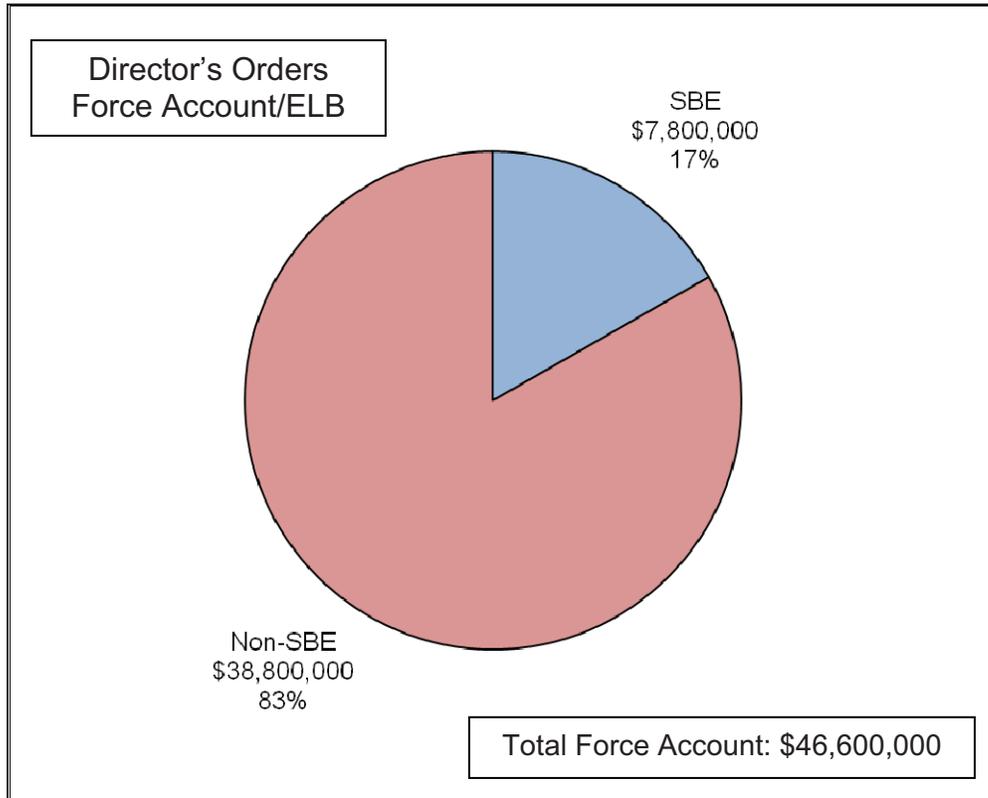
