September 25, 2008 Update **U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa**

Openings and Closures

- **3rd Street - Southbound U.S. 101 On-Ramp** –The full closure of the 3rd Street on-ramp to southbound U.S. 101 began Thursday, May 1. The on-ramp will continue to be closed until Friday, October 31.
- **3rd Street – Northbound U.S. 101 Off-Ramp** – The full closure of the 3rd Street off-ramp from northbound U.S. 101 began Tuesday, August 20. The off-ramp will remain closed to northbound U.S. 101 traffic until October 8, 2008.
- **Steele Lane:**
 - **Southbound Off-Ramp** – Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night.
 - **Southbound On-Ramp** - Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night.
 - **Northbound Off-Ramp** – Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - **Northbound On-Ramp** - Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night.
- **Southbound Downtown Santa Rosa Off-Ramp**- Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night.

- **Dutton Avenue:** On-ramp to eastbound State Route 12 will be closed Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night.
- **Southbound U.S. 101 Connector to State Route 12 West & East:** The connector ramp to State Route 12 east and westbound will be closed from U.S. 101 south. The closure will take place Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night. Flaggers and CMS signs will be on site to detour traffic.
- **Eastbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 North & South:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 north and south from State Route 12 eastbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night. Flaggers and CMS signs will be on site to detour traffic.
- **Westbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 South:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 south from State Route 12 westbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. Flaggers and CMS signs will be on site to detour traffic.

- **Westbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 North:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 north from State Route 12 westbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. Flaggers and CMS signs will be on-site to detour traffic.

Current Status U.S. 101:

- **Prince Memorial Greenway:** No closures scheduled at this time.

Other:

- **U.S. 101 Northbound Various Lanes (Petaluma – Cloverdale):** Caltrans has announced that the metal-beam guardrail installation project will continue beginning Monday, **September 29** along U.S. 101. The right lane will be closed throughout the corridor with the left lane remaining open to traffic at all times. The hours of operation will be Monday through Friday from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Further detailed information is expected to follow in future updates.
- **State Route 12 Farmers Lane to Montgomery:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin striping removal in preparation for an asphalt paving project along State Route 12 from Farmers Lane to Montgomery. Work is tentatively scheduled to begin Monday, September 29 through Thursday, October 3 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Once striping removal is complete crews will microseal the roadway. There will be flaggers on-site to direct traffic.
- **State Route 12 Kunde Winery Road to Kenwood Inn:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin work on utilities along State Route 12 at Kunde Winery Road beginning Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. There will be one-way traffic control and flaggers will be on-site to direct traffic. The expected delay during this work is estimated to be around 15 minutes.
- **Highway 116 Monte Cristo Avenue:** Caltrans has announced that crews will do shoulder widening near Monte Cristo Avenue along State Route 12 on Wednesday, October 1 and Thursday, October 2 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. There will be one-way traffic control and flaggers will be on-site to direct traffic. The expected delay during this work is estimated to be around 15 minutes.

- **Highway 116 Westbound Mount Vernon Road/Hessel Road to Lone Pine Road:** Caltrans has announced that crews will be digging and paving for a driveway approach along the roadway. Crews will begin work on Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. There will be intermittent traffic control and occasional one-way traffic control as needed. There will be flaggers on-site to direct traffic. The expected delay during this work is estimated to be around 15 minutes.
- **State Route 12 at Waterman Avenue:** There will be one-way traffic control as maintenance crews will be working on the water and sewer lines along westbound State Route 12 near Waterman Avenue. The work will continue Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3. One-way traffic control will be in affect from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. There will be flaggers on-site to direct traffic. The expected delay during this work is estimated to be around 15 minutes.
- **U.S. 101 Lytton Spring Road to South Geyserville:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin work on a concrete replacement slab project Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3. There will be rolling lane and on and off-ramp closures northbound and southbound on U.S. 101 between the hours of 6 p.m. and 1 p.m. each day. Flaggers will be on-site to direct traffic. Please refer to traffic advisory for further details.
- **Highway 116 Westbound at South Main Street and Petaluma Avenue:** Caltrans has announced that traffic will be shifted Monday, September 29 through Friday, October 3 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Crews will be working on the curbs and gutters along the shoulder. There will be flaggers on-site to direct traffic each day.
