October 16, 2008 Update **U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa**

Openings and Closures

- **3rd Street - Southbound U.S. 101 On-Ramp** –The full closure of the 3rd Street on-ramp to southbound U.S. 101 began Thursday, May 1. The on-ramp will continue to be closed until Friday, October 31.
- **3rd Street – Northbound U.S. 101 Off-Ramp** – The 3rd Street off-ramp was re-opened Friday, October 3 to U.S. 101 northbound traffic. The original re-opening date for the off-ramp was scheduled for Wednesday, October 8.
 - **3rd Street Off-Ramp will be closed Saturday, October 18 from 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. and on Friday, October 24 from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m.**

- **Southbound U.S. 101 Connector to State Route 12 West & East:** The connector ramp to State Route 12 east and westbound will be closed from U.S. 101 south. The crossover will be closed Saturday, October 18 from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Further closures will take place throughout the week. Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Friday, October 24 from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Flaggers and CMS signs will be onsite to detour traffic.
- **Eastbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 North & South:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 north and south from State Route 12 eastbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Friday, October 24 from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Flaggers and CMS signs will be onsite to detour traffic.
- **Westbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 South:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 south from State Route 12 westbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Friday, October 24 from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Flaggers and CMS signs will be onsite to detour traffic.

- **Westbound State Route 12 Connector Ramp to U.S. 101 North:** The connector ramp to U.S. 101 north from State Route 12 westbound will be closed. The closure will take place Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. and Friday, October 24 from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Flaggers and CMS signs will be onsite to detour traffic.

Current Status U.S. 101:

- **Prince Memorial Greenway:** No closures scheduled at this time.

Other:

- **U.S. 101 Northbound Various Lanes (Petaluma – Cloverdale):** Caltrans has announced that the metal-beam guardrail installation project will continue with tree removal which began Monday, **October 6** along U.S. 101 northbound in Petaluma. The right lane will continue to be closed at night from Petaluma to Cloverdale with the left lane remaining open to traffic at all times. The hours of operation will continue to be Monday through Friday from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Various ramps will be closed along the corridor for short periods of time. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic. Work is expected to continue for approximately three weeks.
- **State Route 12 - Warm Springs Road and Kunde Ranch Road:** A permit project to install a left turn lane will require daily one-way traffic control will continue Monday, October 20 through Friday, October 24 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. along State Route 12 from Warm Springs Road to Kunde Ranch Road. There will be flaggers onsite to direct traffic. Motorists are advised to expect minor delays.
- **U.S. 101 - Lytton Spring Road to South Geyserville:** Caltrans has announced that crews will continue work on a concrete replacement slab project Monday, October 20 through Friday, October 24. There will be daily rolling lane and on and off-ramp closures northbound and southbound on U.S. 101 from approximately 6 p.m. through 1 p.m. the following day. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic.

- **Highway 1- Breakers Beach to Halcyon:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin a culvert repair project along the coast on Highway 1 near Gualala. Work will begin Monday, October 13 through Friday, October 17 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day, an update will be sent out each week until the work is completed. One-way traffic control will be in place and flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic, 15 to 20 minute delays are expected.
- **Highway 1- Burke Avenue to Russian Gulch:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin a drainage improvement and repair project along the coast on Highway 1 near Jenner. Work will begin Monday, October 20 through Friday, October 24 from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. each day, an update will be sent out each week until the work is completed. Work is expected to complete continue for two weeks and is weather dependent. One-way traffic control will be in place and flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic, 15 to 20 minute delays are expected.
- **Highway 1- Kent Avenue to Taylor Street:** Caltrans has announced that crews will begin a drainage improvement and repair project along the coast on Highway 1 in Bodega Bay. Work will begin Monday, October 20 through Friday, October 24 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day, an update will be sent out each week until the work is completed. One-way traffic control will be in place and flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic, 15 to 20 minute delays are expected.
- **State Route 12 - Farmers Lane to Montgomery:** Caltrans has announced that crews will continue an asphalt paving and striping project along State Route 12 from Farmers Lane to Montgomery. Crews will work Monday, October 20 through Thursday, October 23 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. There will be flaggers onsite to direct traffic

Maintenance:

- **State Route 12 - Waterman Avenue:** There will be one-way traffic control as maintenance crews will be working on the water and sewer lines along westbound State Route 12 near Waterman Avenue. The work will continue Monday, October 20 through Friday, October 24. One-way traffic control will be in affect from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. There will be flaggers onsite to direct traffic. The expected delay during this work is estimated to be around 15 minutes.
