January 30, 2009 Update

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa:

US 101 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lanes were opened on Monday, November 10 to motorists traveling north and southbound. The hours of operation are 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. in both directions from the US 101/Highway 12 Interchange to Steele Lane.

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Steele Lane in Santa Rosa to Windsor River Road in the Town of Windsor.

- **Steele Lane to Windsor River Road:** Crews will continue work in the median for k-rail placement. There will be rolling closures in both the north and southbound directions during these hours.
 - **US 101 Southbound** - Sunday, February 1 through Friday, February 6 the number 1 and 2 lanes will alternate closures 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - **US 101 Northbound** - Sunday, February 1 through Friday, February 6 the number 1 and 2 lanes will alternate closures 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- **On-Ramp & Off-Ramp – US 101 North & Southbound:** On and off-ramps throughout the project zone may be subject to intermittent closures if needed. Crews will post Changeable Message Signs in advance to notify motorists.
- **Steele Lane to Windsor River Road: Crews began tree-removal on Monday, January 12.** The removal of 342 trees along US 101 from Windsor River Road to Steele Lane is the first stage of the U.S. 101 Widening and High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane Project from Steele Lane to Windsor River Road. Tree-removal is expected to continue for three to four weeks. Work will be done at night following the above construction schedule.

Other:

- **Highway 12 – Trinity Road and Arnold Drive (Glen Ellen):** Crews have completed tree-removal along Highway 12 near Glen Ellen. Highway widening and roadway realignment will continue in May 2009. Construction has currently moved into winter suspension.
- **Highway 12 – Sidewalk and Street Improvement- Agua Caliente to Boyes Boulevard:** The Sonoma County Highway 12 Sidewalk and Street Improvement Project will continue work Monday, February 2 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. through Friday, February 6. To keep one lane open in each direction during construction, a traffic shift may occur that will eliminate the center turn lane during construction. Work will be noisy and may cause minor inconveniences when trying to access local businesses. Traffic delays are estimated between five to ten minutes in both directions. - **Highway 1 – Kent Avenue to Taylor Street:** There will be one-way traffic control from Kent Avenue to Taylor Street on Highway 1. One-way traffic control will begin Monday, February 2 through Friday, February 6 from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic.
- **Highway 1 – North of Jenner:** There will be one-way traffic control at Meyers Grade Road just north of Jenner while crews work to install a signal along Highway 1. One-way traffic control will continue Monday, February 2 seven days a week, from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily. Flaggers will be onsite to direct traffic.

Maintenance:

- **Highway 37 – Petaluma Creek Bridge to Lakeville Road:** Crews will be closing a lane on westbound Highway 37 at the Petaluma Creek Bridge to Lakeville Road beginning Monday, February 2 through Friday, February 6 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. Crews will be repairing asphalt along the roadway.
- **Highway 116 – Monte Cristo Avenue:** There will be one-way traffic control Monday, February 2 and Tuesday, February 3 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Crews will be working on utilities along the roadway on Highway 116 near Monte Cristo Avenue.

- **Highway 116 – Crescent Avenue:** There will be one-way traffic control on Highway 116 at Crescent Avenue Friday, February 6. Crews will be working along the roadway between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 p.m. (noon).
- **Highway 12 – Randolph Avenue to Shaw Avenue:** There will be one-way traffic control on Highway 12 from Randolph Avenue to Shaw Avenue Monday, February 2 through Friday, February 6. Crews will be working along the roadway between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. each day
