


State Route 12 Connector Ramps to Northbound U.S. 101 Santa Rosa to Close for 34 Hours Starting 11:59 pm June 15

Caltrans will close the westbound and eastbound State Route 12 connector ramps to northbound U.S. 101 in Santa Rosa from 11:59 pm Friday, June 15 until 8:00 am Sunday, June 17. The total closure time should not exceed thirty-four hours. Ramps will remain closed day and night.

Crews require this full closure to grade the pavement and equalize the elevations between State Route 12 and U.S. 101. This is part of the U.S. 101 widening project.

Changeable message signs and detours will be posted. The California Highway Patrol will assist with staffing the closure and detours.



- Detours**
- For westbound State Route 12 to northbound U.S. 101
- Continue past closed ramp to the southbound 101 connector ramp (loop).
 - Proceed on Route 101 south to the next exit, Baker Avenue.
 - Continue straight, going on bridge over freeway.
 - Turn right at Santa Rosa Avenue
 - Turn immediately right onto north 101 onramp.
- For eastbound State Route 12 to northbound U.S. 101
- Take U.S. 101 south connector ramp instead of closed ramp
 - Proceed on U.S. 101 South to the next exit, Baker Avenue
 - Continue straight, going on bridge over freeway
 - Turn right at Santa Rosa Avenue
 - Turn immediately right onto northbound U.S. 101 onramp
