



January 12, 2007 Update

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa

All work dates are tentative as the rainy season impacts construction.

Openings and Closings

- Crews successfully switched traffic to the new freeway center bridge at College Avenue on southbound U.S. 101.
- The westernmost College Avenue southbound bridge is scheduled for demolition starting Tuesday, January 16 through Friday, January 19 at night with College Avenue undercrossing closed from 10pm to 6am. Crews will likely close the southbound College Avenue off and on ramps with this demolition, with the offramp closing at 8pm and the onramp closing at 10pm.
- Throughout the coming weeks, either lane in both the northbound or southbound direction of U.S. 101 will temporarily close as needed, from 10pm to 5am between State Route 12 to Steele Lane. Crews will adjust the concrete barrier as a necessary safety measure throughout the work site during the temporary closures.
- Fifth and Ninth Streets remain closed. Demolition and excavation work is underway at the bridges. Ninth Street is open for pedestrian and bicycle traffic.
- The Third Street offramp from northbound U.S. 101 is open, as is the Third Street undercrossing.
- The Prince Memorial Greenway is open.

Other

- Crews continue pile driving on Sixth Street during the day. This loud work is critical for building new structures to support the freeway. Thank you for your patience with the noisy day work.
