U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa



Widening Work, Traffic Impacts, Openings, and Closures

- The southbound Third Street onramp and the ramps from southbound 101 to State Route 12, both eastbound and westbound, will be closed overnight Tuesday, August 28.
- Crews are building soundwalls and retaining walls along the southbound side of the freeway. Some nighttime ramp closures are necessary during this construction.
- Farmers Lane is a Caltrans staging area. There are currently no active plans to extend eastbound S.R. 12.

Santa Rosa Creek and Fourth Street Viaduct

- Bridge building over Santa Rosa Creek continues with form work on the southbound bridge and rebar work on the northbound bridge.
- The Greenway is closed through October 2007 for bridge construction.
- Fourth Street remains closed as crews continue to resolve utility issues.

Sixth and Ninth Streets

- Shoring and excavation is scheduled for completion at Sixth Street.
- **Sixth Street and College Avenue undercrossing construction should begin as a separate project from the widening in Spring 2009.**
- At Ninth Street the closure walls are curing.
 - Ninth Street remains open to bicycle and pedestrian traffic.

College Avenue and Steele Lane

- College Avenue undercrossing will be closed overnight Monday, August 27 and Tuesday, August 28 for a closure pour.
- Crews will demolish a College Avenue bridge in September. This bridge is the final College Avenue bridge to be demolished as part of the widening project.
- Crews continue with accelerated bridge work at Steele Lane.
- The week's work includes lost deck and rebar construction.
- Crews are tentatively scheduled to lower the latest bridge sometime around Sunday, September 23 or Monday, September 24.

Other

- Demolition work at the Railroad Overhead and Olive Avenue has been postponed.
- Throughout the life of the project, either lane in both the northbound and/or southbound direction of U.S. 101 will temporarily close as needed, from 10:00pm to 5:00am between State Route 12 and Steele Lane.
