U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa



Widening Work, Traffic Impacts, Openings, and Closures

- Crews are building soundwalls and retaining walls along the southbound side of the freeway. Some nighttime ramp closures are necessary during this construction.
- Farmers Lane is a Caltrans staging area. There are currently no active plans to extend eastbound S.R. 12.

Santa Rosa Creek and Fourth Street Viaduct

- Bridge building over Santa Rosa Creek continues with finishing, stressing, grouting, and stripping falsework on the southbound bridge and deck rebar and concrete work on the northbound bridge.
- The Greenway is closed through October 2007 for bridge construction.
- Fourth Street remains closed until sometime in November.

Sixth and Ninth Streets

- Sixth Street daytime pile driving continues. **This is noisy work.** Further bridge building has commenced at Sixth Street as well.
- **Sixth Street and College Avenue undercrossing construction should begin as a separate project from the widening project in Spring 2009.**
- At Ninth Street crews continue work on the closure walls.
 - Ninth Street remains open to bicycle and pedestrian traffic.

College Avenue and Steele Lane

- College Avenue work continues with a closure pour on Tuesday, September 18.
- Traffic will switch on southbound U.S. 101 at College over several nights in mid-October.
- Crews will demolish the last existing College Avenue bridge in November after the traffic switch.
- Crews are scheduled to lower the final Steele Lane bridge overnight Tuesday, September 18 and Wednesday, September 19 with an early undercrossing closure beginning at 8:00pm and lasting until 6:00am each evening. Steele Lane on and off ramps will be closed both nights as well.

Other

- Demolition work at the Railroad Overhead and Olive Avenue has been postponed.
- Throughout the life of the project, either lane in both the northbound and/or southbound direction of U.S. 101 will temporarily close as needed, from 10:00pm to 5:00am between State Route 12 and Steele Lane.
