



July 21, 2006 Update

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa

Closures

- Steele Lane continues to have a reduced number of lanes through 2008, but remains open 24 hours a day.
- College Avenue continues to have reduced lanes through 2008, but remains open 24 hours a day. Reconfiguration of the lanes will tentatively take place around **August 4**. Detailed information will be released as it becomes available.
- The Third Street undercrossing of U.S. 101 continues to be closed.
- The Downtown/Third Street offramp continues to be closed.
- There may be various short-term, overnight lane closures along the roadway, connectors, and ramps as crews continue to place concrete barriers, clear medians, and begin rough grading.

Construction

- The Prince Memorial Greenway has closed until Fall. Crews are constructing retaining walls in the area. The public is reminded that this is an active construction area and to please use the pedestrian overcrossing detour and not enter the construction zone.
- At Steele Lane crews will be working on the wall at abutment 1, the footing at abutment 2, and building the soundwall. No lane closures are expected.
- College Avenue work includes pouring the wall at abutment 1 and backfilling and pouring concrete into forms at abutment 3. Falsework for the superstructure should begin toward the later part of the week. Around **mid-August**, crews anticipate reconfiguring the lanes so that they may be able to work on abutment 3. More information will be provided on this reconfiguration as it becomes available.

Other issues

- Crews are making efforts to keep dust at a minimum as they do work at the median and structures.
