



September 29, 2006 Update

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa

Overnight Closures

- **Steele Lane** will be closed for bridge lowering above the roadway sometime around October 13. This work will most likely take place 9pm to 6am.
- **College Avenue** will be closed for bridge lowering over the roadway sometime around October 12. The work is scheduled to take place between 9pm and 6am.

Median Work

- The center lanes in both the northbound and southbound directions of U.S. 101 will close from 10pm to 5am Sunday, October 1 through Sunday, October 8. The work area extends from State Route 12 to Steele Lane. Crews will perform work at the median during these closures. Motorists are advised to drive with care, especially as large trucks are entering and exiting the work zone via the closed lanes. The California Highway Patrol will assist with these operations.

Openings and Closings

- Caltrans will reopen Third Street sometime around the end of October, with Fifth and Ninth Streets closing at the same time. More precise dates will be released as construction progresses and dates can be finalized.
- The Third Street offramp is scheduled to open around the end of October. Again, more details will be released as they become available.
- The Prince Memorial Greenway is scheduled to reopen around Thanksgiving.

Other Area Work

- Tree crews will begin work along U.S. 101 shortly, as they finished their work along State Route 12.
- Median and shoulder mowing continues on SR 12.
- Paving work, unrelated to the widening project, begins this week, with work extending from Cotati to Healdsburg. There will be no paving work in the widening project work area. This work is to repair damaged roadway only.
