



## **October 30, 2006 Update**

### **U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa**

#### **Openings and Closings**

- The Third Street offramp is scheduled to open Tuesday, October 31 at 6am. In preparation for this, crews will close the northbound State Route 12 connector ramp and the number two, or outside lane, Monday night from 10pm to 6am.
  - The Third Street offramp will close from 10pm-6am Tuesday, October 31 through Thursday, November 2 so that crews can complete the barrier rail on the offramp.
  - There will be some lane closures at night above the creek for crews to place concrete barrier and to complete bridge demolition.
- Caltrans will reopen Third Street in mid-November, with Fifth and Ninth Streets closing shortly after that.
- **College Avenue** is scheduled to close for false work removal and bridge lowering Tuesday, November 7 through Friday, November 10. The work is scheduled to take place between 9pm and 6am.
- The Prince Memorial Greenway is scheduled to reopen around Thanksgiving.

#### **Traffic Swith**

- Around November 17, traffic will switch from Stage 1 to Stage 2. On southbound 101, traffic will shift to the new center bridge at Steele Lane as crews prepare to demolish the old southbound bridge at Steele Lane. More details will be provided for the traffic switch as they become available.

#### **Median Work**

- The median grading work is nearing completion. The outside, or number one lanes, will continue to be closed in both the northbound and southbound directions as needed at night.

#### **Speed Reduction**
