



December 18, 2006 Update

U.S. 101 Widening Project, Santa Rosa

All work dates are tentative as the rainy season impacts construction.

Openings and Closings

- Crews will close the northbound and southbound number one, or passing lanes, Monday, December 18, from 10:00pm to 6:00am to make adjustments to the concrete barrier. Crews will also be performing similar operations on the northbound U.S. downtown ramp on the same schedule.
- Crews are tentatively scheduled to begin railing demolition work on the Olive Street Bridge and South Santa Rosa Overhead sometime next week between the hours of 10:00pm and 6:00am.
 - On Tuesday, December 19, from 10:00pm to 6:00am, the Dutton Street onramp to State Route 12 eastbound and State Route 12 eastbound to the southbound 101 ramp will be closed as crews install concrete barriers.
- College Avenue's traffic will likely switch sometime around Tuesday, December 26. This southbound traffic switch will be similar to the earlier switch instituted at Steele Lane.
 - Prior to the switch, crews may close one southbound lane at a time to prepare the roadway for the traffic switch. Please watch for crews as concrete barriers are placed and other equipment is at work on the freeway. Rain may delay this operation.
 - The westernmost College Avenue southbound bridge is scheduled for demolition sometime after the New Year.
- Fifth and Ninth Streets remain closed. Demolition and excavation work is underway at the bridges. Ninth Street is open for pedestrian and bicycle traffic.
- The Third Street offramp from northbound U.S. 101 is open, as is the Third Street undercrossing.
- The Prince Memorial Greenway is open.

Other

- Crews are scheduled to drive piles this week at Steele Lane and possibly at Sixth Street. This loud work is critical for building new structures to support the freeway. Thank you for your patience with the noisy day work.
