Traffic Shifts on Redwood and Maacama Bridges in Sonoma County

Healdsburg - Caltrans reached an important milestone today, June 13, 2011, when traffic was shifted onto the newly-built section of the Maacama Bridge on State Highway 128 in Sonoma County.

The bridge is in the process of being replaced with a new, wider structure that is built to current standards. Today, traffic was placed on the newly-built structure. Crews will now start the job of demolishing the remains of the old structure, and building the rest of the new bridge.

Tomorrow, June 14, the same process will take place on the nearby Redwood Creek Bridge. Caltrans expects to complete construction of both new bridges by this fall.

One-way traffic control will remain in place until the completion of the project.
