Repair Work

Devil's Slide (post mile 39.14)

- The road was opened shortly after 9:00 AM Thursday August 3. Traffic immediately began using the road. News organizations were informed via the Bay Area News Service at approximately 10:20 PM. Caltrans District 4 used CMS to inform motorists about the road opening. News crews started arriving in Pacifica at 4:30 AM today to report on the road opening.



Traffic across the repair site this morning

- Electrical contractor St. Francis Electric continued to work on the slide sensor system.



Working on the electrical systems today

- Drilling horizontal drains 30 to 40 feet below the road continued today. The drains will run 300 feet into the mountain. The first of six planned drains is at 50 feet. Work will be based on a 7 day week 12 hour shift during daylight hours. The location presents an unacceptable safety risk for this work during the hours of darkness.
