

## Notes Caltrans District 4 Bicycle Advisory Committee

**1. I-80 Cypress Bikeway Power Point Presentation (Item moved up from #6)**

Staff is investigating a connection to the east span of the Bay Bridge through Emeryville. The proposal includes a Class I path west of East Bay Municipal Utility District and a class III bikeway to Burna Rd to provide a connection of the bridge when it is open.

**1. Request Caltrans to Post PID's that have potential Bike and Pedestrian Nexus.**

In an attempt to assure that Caltrans is complying with Deputy Directive 64, the committee discussed reviewing PIDs for projects that might contain bicycle or pedestrian components or could have an affect on bike/ped projects.

PIDs would be useful if posted on the web that included post miles, description and contact information. Local agencies are responsible for completing the PID.

Caltrans indicated a proposal to list all the PIDs was made to headquarters. Pat Pang was going to check if PIDs can be provided to the group.

**2. Discuss Guidelines and suggestions for Traffic signals located on State Right of Way to detect Bikes and Motorcycles; AB 1581 was passed in 2007: this bill requires Caltrans to provide bicycle guidelines.**

Local agencies can't comply with the new law until Caltrans provides recommendations for bicycle and motorcycle detection guidelines. The CTCDC subcommittee is working on the guidelines. Jennifer Stanley reported that a new wireless detector holds promise for detection.

**3. Status of 9 Bay Area County Bike Plans and Gap Closure priorities submitted by MTC.**

Counties submitted bundled bicycle and pedestrian projects to MTC as part of the Regional Transportation Plan – Transportation 2035, call for projects. MTC is in the process of updating the Regional Bicycle Plan and includes an inventory of county bike plans. Maps of the Regional Bicycle Network are available from MTC's website.

**4. Report on Matrix of past issues; include Jurisdiction in Matrix format and the following items:**

Julian Carroll updated the matrix and eliminated non-active projects. The matrix will be posted in Excel format to the Caltrans website. The website will be up shortly.

**5. Mokelumne Aqueduct Path over-crossing at State Route 4 new Bypass**

A full report will be discussed at the July meeting. Measure J funds were not approved. AB 2971 funds might be available.
