Paving Continues for Southbound U.S. 101 Traffic to Detour at Wilfred Ave. Interchange Project January 4

SONOMA COUNTY– Caltrans continues paving to prevent potholes on southbound U.S. 101 from south of Santa Rosa to Rohnert Park.

Tuesday, January 4

Tuesday night, January 4, if weather permits, the Caltrans contractor will repair potholes on southbound U.S. 101 adjacent to the Wilfred Avenue Interchange project site. Traffic will be detoured from mainline southbound U.S. 101 during this work. California Highway Patrol officers will be present during the detour and temporary lane and ramp closures.

- **9 p.m.** The right lane will be closed and traffic reduced to one lane.
- Southbound Wilfred Ave. on and off ramp will also be closed. Local traffic will not be able to enter southbound U.S. 101 from Wilfred Ave. Traffic will not be able to exit southbound U.S. 101 to Wilfred Ave. These ramp closures are necessary for the following detour.
- **10 p.m.** Traffic will be detoured.
- Speed will be reduced to 25 M.P.H.
- Traffic will exit U.S. 101 and immediately re-enter U.S. 101 at the Wilfred Ave. on-ramp.

Wednesday, January 5

- **5 a.m.** Southbound U.S. 101 lanes will reopen.
- Wilfred Ave. on-ramp and off-ramp will reopen for local traffic.

Wednesday Night

Work will continue on southbound U.S. 101 just north of Penngrove at the Willowbrook Creek Bridge, left lane, from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
