CALTRANS ANNOUNCES BRIDGE DECK CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN FRESNO AND MADERA COUNTY

WHAT: BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
WHEN: WEEK OF MONDAY, AUGUST 3RD, (NO WEEKEND OR HOLIDAY WORK)
WHERE: FRESNO AND MADERA COUNTIES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that **Truesdell Corporation** will begin bridge sealing and/or joint seal replacement and bridge deck grinding with hot mix overlay operations on various structures beginning the week of August 3rd and continuing until September 2015. **Each week, normal night work will begin Sunday evenings until 6:00 a.m. the following morning, however, day-time work will occur at the I-5 locations listed below from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. each day.**

The following locations within Fresno and Madera counties will be subject to night-time lane & ramp closures:(Locations are subject to change at any time due to weather or unforeseen contractor operations at scheduled locations).

- **SR 41/Sierra Ave Overcrossing** (Fresno Co) Night Time Work
- **SR 41/ Alluvial Ave Undercrossing** (Fresno Co) 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- **SR 41/Friant Road Undercrossing** (Fresno Co) 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- **SR 99/Dry Creek Bridge** (Madera Co) 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
- **SR 99/Ash Slough Bridge** (Madera Co) 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
