## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES RAMP CLOSURES THIS SUNDAY

**WHAT:** TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TRAFFIC LANE, CONNECTOR RAMPS & OFF-RAMPS TO BE CLOSED FOR HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE, GUARDRAIL REPAIR & LANDSCAPE OPERATIONS.

**WHEN:** SUNDAY MORNING, MAY 19<sup>TH</sup> FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M.

**WHERE:** WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO; VARIOUS LOCATIONS

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will conduct highway pavement crack sealing repairs, guardrail and sand barrel repairs, electrical repairs, striping and landscape operations this weekend **Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.** in order to minimize traffic impacts to motorists during the week. Safety procedures within the project limits will require the full closure of the #3 travel lane and shoulder closures at these locations. The following connectors, off-ramps and travel lane will be closed beginning at 8:00 a.m:

- Westbound State Route (SR) 168 connector ramp to westbound SR 180
- Westbound (SR) 180 connector ramp to northbound & southbound SR41
- Westbound SR 180 #3 lane (slow lane) between SR 168 and SR 41 Interchange
- Eastbound SR 180 Connector Ramp to northbound and southbound 41
- Southbound Tulare Avenue off-ramp
- Westbound SR 168 McKinley Avenue loop on-ramp
- Northbound SR 41 McKinley Avenue loop off-ramp
- Abby Avenue Eastbound 180 on-ramp
- Abby Avenue Eastbound 180 off-ramp (**Closed from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m.**)

These scheduled closures will occur, weather & schedule permitting. Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. Caltrans would like to thank the local residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during these closures and reminds you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time to your commute. Please be alert for Road Maintenance Personnel, adhere to posted signage and please **“Slow for the Cone Zone” at all times.**
