## SEGMENT OF STATE ROUTE 14 TO BE REPAVED WITH STIMULUS FUNDING

**WHO:** THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS) IN COOPERATION WITH WINDSOR FUEL COMPANY, OF PITTSBURG, CALIFORNIA WILL BEGIN A PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT.

**WHAT:** THE \$787-BILLION AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT PROVIDED THE FUNDING FOR THE \$4.8-MILLION PROJECT TO REHABILITATE THE PAVEMENT AND SHOULDERS ON TWO SEGMENTS OF STATE ROUTE 14.

**WHERE:** 25 MILES OF STATE ROUTE 14 FROM NORTH OF BUSINESS ROUTE 58 NEAR MOJAVE TO 5.3 MILES NORTH OF THE CALIFORNIA CITY BOULEVARD OVERCROSSING AND FROM 1.1 MILES NORTH OF REDROCK CANYON ROAD TO STATE ROUTE 178.

**WHEN:** WORK WILL BEGIN THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 7, 2009. WORK HOURS: MONDAYS THROUGH FRIDAYS FROM 6 A.M. TO 5 P.M. THE PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETE BY FALL OF 2009.

**DETOUR:** LANE CLOSURES WILL OCCUR THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT. MOTORISTS WILL BE ALERTED VIA CONSTRUCTION SIGNS AND ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARDS ALONG STATE ROUTE 14 NEAR LANE CLOSURES.

Caltrans thanks motorists for their patience as we rehabilitate this segment of State Route 14. Motorists are reminded to allow additional travel time and drive with extra care through construction zones. Please **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
