STATE ROUTE 180 CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES **WEEK OF FEBRUARY 18th - NO NEW LANE CLOSURES**

WHAT: **EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180:** THE INSTALLATION OF THE NEW BRIDGE FOUNDATIONS CONTINUES.
WESTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180: CONSTRUCTION OF RETAINING WALLS AND ASPHALT REMOVAL ALONG THE WESTBOUND SHOULDER CONTINUES. REDUCED TRAFFIC LANES AND NEW TRAFFIC PATTERNS CONTINUE TO BE IN PLACE ON STATE ROUTE (SR) 180 AND THE SR 180 ON-RAMPS FROM SR 168 AND SR 41.

WHERE: **CITY OF FRESNO; SR 180 BETWEEN SR 168 AND SR 41.**
