STATE ROUTE 180 CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES **WEEK OF AUGUST 12TH - NO NEW LANE CLOSURES**

WHAT: **EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180:** CONCRETE PAVING CONTINUES.
WESTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180: CONSTRUCTION OF RETAINING WALLS AND GRADING FOR ROADWAY.
FIRST STREET: CONSTRUCTION OF BRIDGE WIDENING CONTINUES. BIKE LANES HAVE BEEN ELIMINATED ON FIRST STREET BETWEEN TYLER AND THOMAS AVENUE.

WHERE: **CITY OF FRESNO; WESTBOUND AND EASTBOUND STATE ROUTE 180 BETWEEN CEDAR AVENUE AND SR 41 INTERCHANGE.**
