State Route 180 Construction Update: **2-month CLOSURE of McCall Avenue** **Beginning Monday Morning.** **Motorists Advised to Use Alternate Routes!**

WHAT: McCall Avenue will be CLOSED—Monday, April 25th beginning at 6AM--to all through traffic at the intersection of SR-180/Kings Canyon Road to construct 2-NEW roadway lanes of SR-180 from Temperance Avenue to Academy Avenue, in Fresno County. Motorists are advised to use an alternate DETOUR in order to avoid 10-15 minute DELAYS within this 6-mile Construction Zone.

WHEN: This CLOSURE will be in place 6AM on Monday, April 25th and remain in place through the beginning of July 2011, weather permitting.

DETOUR: All motorists are advised to use Belmont or Jensen Avenues to avoid the Construction Zone and to use Temperance or Academy Avenues to travel north or southbound from SR-180.

SCHEDULE: This \$27 million project is locally funded by Fresno County's ½ cent Transportation Sales Tax, "Measure C" & was leveraged with Federal Stimulus Money. It is scheduled for completion in the Fall of 2011, weather permitting
