State Route 180 Construction Update: 20-30 minute DELAYS on SR-180/Re-Open Academy & switch traffic to NEW lanes

DETOUR: Tomorrow & Thursday, motorists are advised to use Belmont or Jensen Avenues to avoid the SR-180 Construction Zone from Temperance to Quality Avenues--Temperance, McCall & Academy Avenues will be OPEN to travel north or southbound from or across SR-180—all other cross-roads will be CLOSED.

WHAT: -Flaggers will be at various locations directing & detouring motorists through the 6-mile Construction Zone with 20-30 minute DELAYS along SR-180 from Temperance to Quality Avenues.
*The following traffic operations will be in place on Friday, 12/3:
-The intersection of SR-180/Academy Avenue will RE-OPEN
-Traffic will be switched to the NEW lanes of SR-180
-The intersections of SR-180/Temperance, McCall & Academy Avenues will be OPEN, all other cross-roads will be CLOSED--motorists must use Jensen Avenue to access businesses or residences South of SR-180.

WHEN: 8AM --- 5PM on December 1 & 2 --- Weather permitting.

SCHEDULE: This \$27 million construction project is locally funded by Fresno County's ½ cent Transportation Sales Tax, "Measure C" & was leveraged with Federal Stimulus Money. It is scheduled for completion in the Summer of 2011, weather permitting.
