STATE ROUTE 198 HANFORD EXPRESSWAY LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR THIS WEEK

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Flatiron Construction will begin night-time lane closures this week as part of the State Route 198 Hanford Expressway Widening Project in Tulare and Kings Counties.

Night-time lane closures will be as follows (weather permitting):

7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. nightly, beginning Tuesday evening, March 23rd and ending Friday morning, March 26th, 2010. There will be no lane closures on Friday or Saturday evening. Construction crews will conduct lane closures utilizing one-way traffic control in Kings County between 3rd Avenue and 5th Avenue and in Tulare County between Road 64 and Road 68. These closures will not run simultaneously, crews will determine, based on need, which location will be affected each night. Commuters will be subject to delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible.

As part of a partnership with The California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present during construction to provide extra support for traffic control.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. The public is asked to drive with extra care while traveling through the construction area and please **Slow of the Cone Zone**.
