### STATE ROUTE 198 HANFORD EXPRESSWAY LANE CLOSURES CONTINUE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Flatiron Construction will continue night-time lane closures next week as part of the State Route 198 Hanford Expressway Widening Project in Kings County.

Night-time lane closures will be as follows (weather permitting):

**7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. nightly, beginning Sunday evening and ending Friday morning of each week. There will be no lane closures on Friday or Saturday evenings. Construction crews will conduct lane closures utilizing one-way traffic control in Kings County approximately 1 mile east of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue to allow heavy equipment to transport materials. Commuters will be subject to delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible.**

**As part of a partnership with The California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present during construction to provide extra support for traffic control.**

This \$50 million dollar project will convert an approximate 10 mile section of existing two lane conventional highway to a four lane controlled access expressway. The project limits are in Kings and Tulare Counties from east of State Route 43 in Hanford to west of State Route 99 near Visalia. Approximately 7 miles are in Kings County, with approximately 3 miles in Tulare County.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. The public is asked to drive with extra care while traveling through the construction area and please **Slow of the Cone Zone**.
