CITY OF FRESNO DEVELOPMENT PROJECT EXPECTED TO CAUSE TRAFFIC DELAYS

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that as part of the ongoing City of Fresno development project located just east of Friant Road near State Route (SR) 41, **Contractor Picket and Sons will conduct continuous 24-hour improvement operations beginning tonight at 9:00 p.m.** These operations will continue for the next three weeks as part of the new Friant Road Shopping Center Development project currently in construction.

It is anticipated that motorists traveling along Northbound SR 41 to northbound Friant Road will be subject to extended delays during the next three weeks due to reduced travel lanes within the project limits. Motorists are advised to use an alternate route or add additional time to their morning or afternoon commute.

Motorists are advised that the northbound Friant right turn lane, or turn lane closest to the right shoulder, will temporarily serve as the primary designated travel lane for motorists turning right onto Fresno Street; as a result, thru traffic must merge left to continue along northbound Friant Road. Portable message signs have been placed along northbound State Route 41, or just south of the Friant Road off-ramp notifying motorists of construction; additional signage will be placed at strategic locations within/near the project limits.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to unforeseen delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction. Caltrans, the City of Fresno and Picket and Sons remind you to always drive with extra care while travelling through construction areas. Please pay attention to signage and lane closures and watch for construction vehicles and personnel working in the area.
