## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES UPCOMING DELAYS ON STATE ROUTE 41 NEAR COARSEGOLD

**WHAT:** ONE-WAY REVERSING TRAFFIC CONTROL OPERATIONS TO INCLUDE FULL CLOSURE OF 20 MINUTE INTERVALS FOR BLASTING OPERATIONS ON STATE ROUTE 41/ RD 416 NEAR COARSEGOLD.

**WHEN:** BEGINNING TUESDAY, JUNE 2<sup>ND</sup> FROM 9:00 A.M. UNTIL 2:00 P.M.  
BLASTING OPERATIONS WILL REQUIRE A MAXIMUM FULL  
HIGHWAY CLOSURE OF UP TO 20 MINUTES FOR ALL VEHICLES.

**WHERE:** MADERA COUNTY, ON STATE ROUTE 41, FROM 0.2 MILES SOUTH TO JUST 0.2 MILES NORTH OF ROAD 416.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that Granite Construction has been awarded a widening contract on State Route 41. As part of this ongoing project, blasting operations will take place on State Route 41 in Madera County beginning on Tuesday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Blasting operations are scheduled to take place for approximately 2-3 weeks. The entire project is scheduled to be completed in winter 2009.

**Pilot cars will be utilized and flaggers will be conducting one-way traffic control operations on State Route 41. Motorists will experience up to 20-minute delays in this area during this time frame. Changeable message signs will be activated notifying motorists of delays. Motorists should use an alternate route whenever possible.**

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. Motorists are reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through this construction project and reminds drivers to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” in all construction and maintenance areas.
