STATE ROUTE 41 CONSTRUCTION GRANGEVILLE/HANFORD-ARMONA RD GRANGEVILLE ACCESS CLOSURE EAST OF STATE ROUTE 41

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Teichert Construction will close access to east Grangeville Boulevard from State Route 41 to perform drainage system installation, as part of the State Route 41 pavement rehabilitation project between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road in Kings County.

The following night closures are scheduled for Sunday- Friday of next week:

East Grangeville Boulevard from State Route 41 in Kings County will be closed beginning Sunday night, June 2nd through Saturday morning June 8th, 2013 between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. each night. Commuters wishing to travel east from State Route 41 will be detoured to Lacey Boulevard or Flint Avenue. Northbound and Southbound State Route 41 will be reduced to one way traffic control at Grangeville Boulevard between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. each night.

Construction Crews will be conducting one way traffic control during this time with the use of flagging personnel through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to road construction vehicles and personnel.

During construction operations, delays can last for up to 15 minutes. Commuters are encouraged to avoid this area during project work hours and use alternate routes if possible.

Caltrans Construction workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling within the project area. Please be alert for Construction Personnel and **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
