CONSTRUCTION TO RESUME ON STATE ROUTE 41 BETWEEN GRANGEVILLE AND HANFORD-ARMONA RD

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Teichert Construction will reduce southbound State Route 41 to one lane between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road in Kings County as construction resumes on a pavement rehabilitation project.

The following closure is scheduled to begin next week (weather permitting):

Southbound State Route 41 will be reduced to one lane between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road beginning Monday, March 18th, 2013. This project is anticipated to be completed in December 2013; weather permitting. Additional lane closures and traffic configurations will be necessary and implemented over the next 9 months in order to rehabilitate pavement and widen shoulders within the project limits. Future commuter alerts will be distributed as these closures occur.

Businesses between Grangeville Boulevard and Hanford-Armona Road on State Route 41 will remain open and access will be maintained during construction.

Caltrans Construction workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling within the project area. Please be alert for Construction Personnel and **“Slow for the Cone Zone.”**
