## PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT POSTPONED NEXT WEEK

**WHAT:** NO CONSTRUCTION TO TAKE PLACE NEXT WEEK ALONG BOTH DIRECTIONS OF STATE ROUTE 41 NORTH OF OAKHURST.

**WHEN:** WEEK OF OCTOBER 29<sup>TH</sup> – NOVEMBER 2<sup>ND</sup> FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 6:00 P.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.

**WHERE:** MADERA COUNTY; STATE ROUTE 41; PROJECT LIMITS ARE FROM JUST SOUTH OF CEDAR VALLEY ROAD TO JUST NORTH OF FISH CAMP AT THE YOSEMITE NATIONAL PARK LINE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and Teichert Construction Company announce construction operations will not take place next week along **State Route (SR) 41 in Madera County, however, additional shoulder backing operations will take place the following week beginning on Monday, November 5th.**

(Schedule subject to change due to weather or unforeseen contractor operations).

**Motorists are advised to reduce speed and adhere to all construction signage when operations are in full force. The safety of our maintenance and construction crews is very important, so please "Slow for the Cone Zone" at all times".**

Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) and lane closure signage will be in place when operations resume notifying motorists of any upcoming closures. During construction, motorists may experience up to a 15-minute traffic delay within the construction areas along SR 41. In order to avoid delays, motorists are encouraged to use an alternate route or add additional time to their morning or afternoon commute.
