CALTRANS REMINDS MOTORISTS OF STATE ROUTE 41 FULL CLOSURE THIS SUNDAY

WHAT: EXTREME MAINTENANCE OPERATIONS ALONG STATE ROUTE (SR) 41 WILL REQUIRE FULL CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND 41 LANES AND RAMPS.

WHEN: **THIS SUNDAY**, OCTOBER 27TH FROM 6:30 A.M.-4:00 P.M.

WHERE: CITY OF FRESNO; SOUTHBOUND (SR) 41 LANES AND RAMPS FROM JUST NORTH OF 41/180 INTERCHANGE TO SR 99/41 INTERCHANGE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces various specialized groups of Caltrans personnel will conduct the following full maintenance crew operations this Sunday along **SOUTHBOUND State Route 41** within the project limits:

- Drainage work
- Pavement Repair/Preventative Maintenance
- Electrical
- Pruning/Dead Vegetation Removal
- Pavement Marking/Striping
- Bridge Maintenance
- Weed & Litter Abatement
- Overhead Signage/Roadway Signage

*******(Northbound State Route 41 lanes and ramps will remain open at all times)*******

The following connectors, frontage street and **SOUTHBOUND** on-ramps **WILL BE COMPLETELY CLOSED** for Full Force Maintenance Operations:

- Southbound McKinley on-ramp to southbound SR41
- Eastbound and Westbound SR 180 connector ramps to southbound SR 41
- Tulare Avenue on-ramp
- "M" Street on-ramp
- San Benito Street (One-way street) between Van Ness & Broadway Street
- Broadway Avenue on-ramp
- Southbound SR 41 Connector to southbound SR 99

Suggested detour: Access westbound State Route 180 to southbound State Route 99

Caltrans thanks commuters, businesses and residents of Fresno County for their patience during these full maintenance closures; however, in order to safely and effectively perform various maintenance functions scheduled along designated sections of State Route 41 full closures are necessary to minimize impacts during the weekly morning or afternoon commute times.

All operations are subject to change due to schedule, weather, early completion or unforeseen circumstances. Caltrans reminds the public to drive safely and to adhere to all posted signage and to be alert for Caltrans personnel working in the area.
