ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL ON STATE ROUTE 41 IN MADERA COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces maintenance crews will be conducting one-way traffic reversing control operations tomorrow morning Saturday, November 21st in order to safely remove dead pine trees along State Route 41 located south of Road 200/O'Neals from 7:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

Motorists are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to tree removal equipment and maintenance personnel at all times. Closure schedule is subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances which may occur during maintenance operations.

During flagging operations, delays are subject to 5-minute delays. Commuters are encouraged to avoid this area during work hours and use alternate routes if possible in order to avoid delays during this time frame.
