## CONNECTOR RAMPS TO STATE ROUTE 41 WILL BE CLOSED NEXT WEEK

**WHAT:** CONTINUING BRIDGE DECK REHABILITATION PROJECT WILL REQUIRE THE CLOSURE OF TWO CONNECTOR RAMPS TO NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41 FROM STATE ROUTE 180 BEGINNING THIS SUNDAY.

**WHEN:** BEGINNING SUNDAY EVENING, OCTOBER 5<sup>TH</sup> FROM 10:00 P.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M. EACH EVENING UNTIL FRIDAY MORNING, OCTOBER 10<sup>TH</sup>.

ADVANCE SIGNAGE WILL BE IN PLACE ADVISING MOTORISTS OF THE CLOSURE.

**WHERE:** WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO, AT THE EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND SR 180 / SR 41 INTERCHANGE

In order to minimize delays during the morning and afternoon commute, construction near the State Route 180 / State Route 41 interchange will require a complete full ramp closure of the following ramps:

- Eastbound State Route 180 connector ramp to northbound State Route 41 will be closed.
- Westbound State Route 180 connector ramp to northbound State Route 41

**Motorists may access northbound State Route 41 from eastbound State Route 180 by the following detour route:**

- Exit eastbound State Route 180 via the southbound State Route 41 connector ramp and exit at the Tulare Street off-ramp
- Turn left and re-enter at the State Route 41 northbound on-ramp

**Motorists may access northbound State Route 41 from westbound State Route 180 by the following detour:**

- Exit westbound State Route 180 via the southbound off-ramp to State Route 41 and exit at the Tulare Street off-ramp
- Turn left and re-enter at the State Route 41 northbound on-ramp

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This project will improve the existing roadway by providing a smoother driving surface at the existing bridge decks along sections of State Route 41 and at the State Route 180 separation. It is anticipated that the entire project will be completed by mid-December 2008. (Weather Permitting)
