WHAT: PARTIAL CLOSURE AND LANE REDUCTION OF STATE ROUTE 41 BETWEEN STATE ROUTE 33 AND STATE ROUTE 46

WHEN: MONDAY, MARCH 22ND THROUGH FRIDAY, MARCH 26TH, 2010 FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M. DAILY

WHERE: ON STATE ROUTE 41, BETWEEN STATE ROUTE 33 AND STATE ROUTE 46 IN KERN COUNTY

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces a partial closure and one way traffic control for construction on State Route 41 between State Route 33 and State Route 46 in Kern County. This daytime partial closure and lane reduction (no passing lane) is necessary to allow Caltrans crews to enhance erosion control and stabilize sloped rock slide areas.

The traveling public will experience a lane reduction with closures of the passing lane within the construction area on State Route 41 during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily on Monday, March 22nd through Friday, March 26th, 2010. Motorists are encouraged to use an alternate route when possible.

Motorists who drive this route will be allowed through the construction area with minimal delays, however at various times traffic will be completely stopped for periods of up to 25 minutes to allow excavation equipment to move within the construction area. This type of closure is necessary to remove debris from the roadway and to ensure the safety of motorists. Flaggers will be on site to assist motorists traveling through the construction area.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this construction project. Motorists are reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through construction areas and to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” in all maintenance and construction areas.


