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MOTORISTS ADVISED NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41 RAMP METERING PROJECT BEGINS NEXT WEEK

WHAT: RAMP METERING PROJECT ALONG NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 41 WILL REQUIRE RAMP AND MAINLINE LANE CLOSURE.

WHEN: BEGINNING NEXT WEEK, TUESDAY, JUNE 8TH FROM 8:00 P.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M. EACH MORNING.

WHERE: WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO, FROM ASHLAN AVE. OVERCROSSING TO JUST NORTH OF BULLARD AVENUE OVERCROSSING.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that **Granite Construction Inc.** has been awarded a ramp metering improvement project along northbound State Route 41 within the City of Fresno. Construction of this project is scheduled to begin next week and is anticipated to be completed in winter 2011. The project limits for this project are from the Ashlan Avenue overcrossing to just north of the Bullard Avenue overcrossing along northbound State Route 41.

The on-ramps at Ashlan Avenue, Shaw Avenue and Bullard Avenues will be subject to intermittent and full ramp closures in order to safely implement this project. At times, intermittent #3 lane closures along State Route 41 mainline will be necessary in order to safely implement the various phases of this project. **It is anticipated that the majority of construction will take place on Sunday evenings from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. each day; (Sunday p.m. -Friday a.m.)**

Next week, intermittent ramps along State Route 41 will be subject to closure, however, at no time will two consecutive on-ramps be closed at the same time. Motorists should expect two lanes of northbound SR 41 to be open to through traffic at all times. **(Schedule subject to change due to weather or unforeseen contractor operations).**
