EXPECT DELAYS ON STATE ROUTE 41 AT YOSEMITE SPRINGS PARKWAY THIS WEEK

WHAT: ONE-WAY REVERSING TRAFFIC CONTROL OPERATIONS TO OCCUR FOR DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 41 IN MADERA COUNTY.

WHEN: BEGINNING TOMORROW, TUESDAY, DECEMBER 15TH UNTIL THURSDAY, DECEMBER 17TH

WHERE: MADERA COUNTY, ON STATE ROUTE 41 NEAR COARSEGOLD

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be conducting an emergency drainage project on State Route 41 in Madera County. Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) will be placed today notifying motorists to expect delays in this area beginning tomorrow.

Construction will consist of shoulder dig outs in order to install additional drainage within the project limits. **The following schedule is currently in place:**

- **Beginning tomorrow morning, Tuesday, Dec 15th at 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. and continuing each morning until Thursday, December 17th at 4:00 p.m. (weather permitting)**

Flaggers will be conducting one-way traffic control operations on State Route 41. Motorists will experience up to 20-minute delays in this area during this time frame. Motorists should use an alternate route whenever possible or allow extra time for their morning or afternoon commute.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. Motorists are reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through this construction project and reminds drivers to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” in all construction and maintenance areas.
