STATE ROUTE 43 & 198 CLOSURES IN KINGS COUNTY SCHEDULED FOR NEXT WEEK

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces scheduled lane and ramp closures throughout Kings County next week to allow Maintenance crews to conduct pavement rehabilitation operations.

The following closures are as scheduled:

Northbound State Route 43 to Eastbound State Route 198 connector ramp will be closed on **Tuesday, May 6th, 2014** between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. This closure will include the #2 lane (right lane) of Eastbound 198 from State Route 43 to 7th Avenue.

Eastbound State Route 198, #2 lane (right lane) between Avenal Cut Off Road and the Kings River will be closed on **Wednesday, May 7th, 2014** from 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Westbound State Route 198, #2 lane (right lane) between the Kings River and Avenal Cut Off Road the will be closed on **Thursday, May 8th, 2014** from 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. This closure will include the Avenal Cut Off ramp (Exit 73). Motorists will need to use 25th Avenue as an alternate exit.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. This scheduled closure will occur, weather permitting. Motorists can expect delays and are encouraged to take an alternate route if possible.

Caltrans Maintenance workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling in Kings County.
