## SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECTS ON STATE ROUTE 43 NEAR HANFORD IN KINGS COUNTY

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces two signal installation projects in and near Hanford within Kings County. These two projects will include the installation of traffic signals at the intersections of State Route 43 and Excelsior Avenue; and State Route 43 and Lacey Boulevard.

The following projects are scheduled to begin on Monday, October 15, 2012:

- Caltrans in cooperation with American Paving and A-C Electric Company will install traffic signals at the intersection of State Route 43 and Lacey Boulevard beginning Monday, October 15, 2012. Once construction is underway, lane closures will occur Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Caltrans in cooperation with Griffith Construction and A-C Electric Company will install traffic signals at the intersection of State Route 43 and Excelsior Avenue beginning Monday, October 15, 2012. Once construction is underway, lane closures will occur Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Additional information will follow on both projects providing specific dates and times of lane closures and one-way traffic control that will be necessary during construction.
