## **-REVISED START DATE NOTIFICATION- CONSTRUCTION REHABILITATION PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 49**

**WHAT:** COLD PLANING OPERATIONS OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT WILL REQUIRE ONE-LANE TRAFFIC REVERSING CONTROL OPERATIONS WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS ON STATE ROUTE 49.

**WHEN:** BEGINNING MONDAY, AUGUST 24<sup>TH</sup> FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M., MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. NO WEEKEND WORK!

**WHERE:** IN MADERA COUNTY, 1.4 MILES WEST OF ROUTE 41/49 INTERSECTION TO THE MADERA / MARIPOSA COUNTY LINE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that Cruco Construction will be conducting an 8-mile highway rehabilitation project on State Route 49 until approximately October 2009. (Weather Permitting)

Construction will consist of highway digouts, cold planing, paving and striping of the existing roadway. It is anticipated that work will begin near the county line towards the community of Oakhurst. Schedule subject to change due to unforeseen contractor operations.

**Flaggers will be conducting one-way traffic control operations on State Route 49. Motorists will experience up to a 15-20 minute delay in this area during this time frame. Motorists should plan to add additional time to their morning commute.**

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their patience during this improvement project. Motorists are reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through this construction project and reminds drivers to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” in all construction and maintenance areas.
