NIGHT WORK ON STATE ROUTE 49 IN MADERA COUNTY WILL CONSIST OF AN ADDITIONAL EVENING

WHAT: HIGHWAY SHOULDER BACKING OPERATIONS OF THE EXISTING PAVEMENT WILL REQUIRE ONE-LANE TRAFFIC REVERSING CONTROL OPERATIONS WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS ON STATE ROUTE 49.

WHEN: THIS WEEK, WEDNESDAY EVENING FROM 8:00 P.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M., AND AGAIN ON THURSDAY EVENING.

WHERE: IN MADERA COUNTY, 0.1 MILE SOUTH OF THE MADERA/ MARIPOSA COUNTY LINE.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that Cruco Construction began shoulder backing roadwork 0.1 mile just south of the Mariposa County line to the Mariposa County Line on State Route 49 on Sunday evening. However, due to contractor operations, an additional evening will be in place this week in order to complete this portion of the project. (Weather Permitting).

The following work is scheduled as follows: (Schedule is subject to change due to unforeseen contractor operations).

- Wednesday, September 2nd, 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 3rd.
- Thursday evening, September 3rd, 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. on Friday, September 4th.

Flaggers will be conducting one-way traffic control operations on State Route 49. Motorists will experience up to a 20-minute delay in this area during this time frame. Motorists should plan to add additional time to their commute time.

Caltrans would like to thank the residents and commuters for their continued patience during this improvement project. Motorists are reminded to drive with extra care while travelling through this construction project and reminds drivers to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” in all construction and maintenance areas.
