STATE ROUTE 58 SAND CANYON BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION TO CONTINUE NEXT WEEK

WHAT: SAND CANYON BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT; WESTBOUND AND EASTBOUND RAMP CLOSURES; WESTBOUND RAMP RECONSTRUCTION

WHEN: SUNDAY, APRIL 7TH THROUGH SATURDAY, APRIL 13TH, 2013

WHERE: ON STATE ROUTE 58 (WEST & EASTBOUND) AT THE SAND CANYON BRIDGE INTERCHANGE, IN KERN COUNTY

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the continued temporary closure of the Sand Canyon Bridge/Interchange as part of the State Route 58 Sand Canyon Bridge Replacement Project. This project will replace existing bridge and reconstruct the westbound on and off ramps. This construction project is expected to be complete in December 2013. Ramp and lane closures will be necessary throughout the project and will change on a weekly basis.

State Route 58 Sand Canyon ramps (both east and westbound; on and off ramps) will be closed Sunday, April 7th through Saturday, April 13th, 2013.

This closure will be 24 hours per day for each of the dates listed above and is necessary to allow construction crews to work in a safe environment and for the safety of the motoring public. Closures may continue for a longer period of time if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during construction.

The public is asked to “**Slow for the Cone Zone**” while traveling through construction areas and reminds motorists to please “**Move Over or Slow Down**” for all Construction, Maintenance and Emergency Response Vehicles working along and near the roadway.
