## ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL STARTING TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11 IN TULARE COUNTY

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct one-way traffic control on several state roadways next week in Tulare County for roadway maintenance.

### The following closures will occur, weather permitting:

- One-way traffic control will occur on State Route 198 between Cherokee Oaks Drive and Eggers Drive on **Tuesday, October 11<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** Motorists may experience delays of approximately 20 minutes during peak traffic times.
- One-way traffic control will occur on State Route 198 between Horse Creek Bridge and Kaweah Lake Marina on **Wednesday, October 12<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** Motorists may experience delays of approximately 20 minutes during peak traffic times.
- Northbound State Route 63 will be reduced to one lane between State Route 137 and Prosperity Avenue on **Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.**
- One-way traffic control will occur on State Route 137 between West Street and Road 84/Enterprise Street on **Friday, October 14<sup>th</sup> between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** Motorists may experience delays of approximately 20 minutes during peak traffic times.

**Maintenance crews will be conducting one-way traffic control at the locations and during the work hours listed above with the use of a pilot car and flagging personnel through the work zone. Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to construction vehicles and personnel at all times.**

**This closure may continue for longer periods of time if necessary, due to delays caused by uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. Motorists may experience delays and are encouraged to take alternate routes whenever possible.**
