## CALTRANS ANNOUNCES EXPECT DELAYS ON STATE ROUTE 99 NEXT WEEK DUE TO NIGHT WORK

**WHAT:** CONCRETE K-RAIL SAFETY BARRIER TO BE INSTALLED NEXT WEEK FOR THE STATE ROUTE 99 NORTH FRESNO SIX LANE WIDENING IMPROVEMENT PROJECT CURRENTLY IN CONSTRUCTION.

**WHEN:** TUESDAY, APRIL 12TH FROM 7:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. UNTIL FRIDAY, APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup>.  
SUNDAY, APRIL 17<sup>TH</sup> FROM 9:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. MONDAY, APRIL 18<sup>TH</sup>.

**WHERE:** WITHIN THE CITY OF FRESNO; IN BOTH DIRECTIONS OF STATE ROUTE 99 FROM 0.2 MILES NORTH OF ASHLAN AVENUE OVERCROSSING TO JUST NORTH OF THE GRANTLAND AVENUE UNDERCROSSING.

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and DeSilva Gates Construction, announce that as part of the **North Fresno 6-Lane Improvement Project** already in construction, motorists will experience extended delays along both directions of State Route (SR) 99 next week for the placement of concrete K-Railing material within this 3.9 mile project segment. (Weather Permitting).

**This four-lane freeway within the project limits will be reduced to one lane of travel in each direction in order to place concrete K-Railing within the median.** As part of this project, any lane closures necessary for construction operations will occur during overnight hours in order to minimize the impacts to motorists during commute times.

Motorists may expect extended delays in this area during this time and are encouraged to avoid this area or use an alternate route whenever possible.

In partnership with the California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present to provide extra support for traffic control. Portable Changeable Message Signs (PCMS) will be in place on State Route 99 notifying motorists of the upcoming lane closures.

Caltrans would like to thank commuters for their patience during this phase of the project. The public is reminded to be alert for construction signage, personnel and please **“Slow for the Cone Zone”** in all Construction and Maintenance Zones at all times.
