CALTRANS ANNOUNCES STATE ROUTE 99 TRAFFIC DETOURS IN MADERA COUNTY

WHAT: DETOUR OF NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 99 TRAFFIC FOR CONCRETE RAILING, GUARD RAIL INSTALLATION AND PAVING OPERATIONS ON STATE ROUTE 99.

WHEN: MONDAY, JULY 26 AND TUESDAY, JULY 27TH FROM 9:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. EACH MORNING.

WHERE: WITHIN THE CITY OF MADERA, SOUTHBOUND/NORTHBOUND SR99 AT THE STATE ROUTE 145 INTERCHANGE.

Traffic will be diverted off of SR 99 in order to remove concrete k-railing, install metal beam guard rail and complete paving on SR 99 at the SR 145 undercrossing. The following detours will be in place next week.

- **Southbound traffic will be diverted off of SR 99 at the SR 145/Madera Avenue off-ramp and diverted back onto the southbound SR 99 on-ramp.**
- **Northbound traffic will be diverted off of SR 99 at the SR 145/ Madera Avenue off-ramp and diverted back onto the northbound SR 99 on-ramp.**

Motorists will experience delays in this area during this time and are encouraged to use an alternate route if possible.

As part of a partnership with the California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present during this time to provide extra support for traffic control. Portable changeable message signs (CMS) will be placed along State Route 99 notifying motorists of the upcoming detours in this area.
